SUNDAY CROSS COUNTRY & HUNTER PACE TRIAL

IMPORTANT INFO

WHAT: In pursuit of Land Conservation, we are continuing to bring awareness to this beautiful piece of land at Bald Rock and where the 1996 Eventing Olympics were held back into working use. Most people have never ridden here. This event will have cross country jump and hunter pace trial competition on that site.

HOW: Via a 3-phase GDCTA sanctioned show, XC only rounds, & hunter pace added to the existing AYDC Schooling Series at the Horse Park Shows. Jumps are temporary as this is public land. Hunter Trial runs will be held in Singles, Pairs or Groups with hilltopping or jumping an option. We encourage you to participate in both the XC & Hunter Trial.

STABLING/TRAILER IN OPTIONS: This day follows a day of our regular Dressage & CT, and now will be a 3-Phase Show, so you may use your stall and ride to this location known as Bald Rock and “The Olympic Rings” from Barn 5, via Gate B or D, and trail ride to the rings. Or you may trailer in and tie out in the parking lot off of Old Costley Mill Road. Or you may trailer your horse from your stall to the parking lot. A Day Stabling **OR** a Grounds Fee Applies.

TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE: **Sat:** Course walk open after 12 noon. **Sun: 9:00** Check In at parking lot of Bald Rock. **10:00** First XC Rounds Begins. Amoeba – Novice will run lowest to highest. **1:00 pm or after completion of XC Hunter Trial. *NEW!! Free Schooling now available with paid entry.***

FEES: 3-Phase: (Sat Dressage & Show Jump, Sunday XC) \$90 Amoeba/Tadpole. \$100 Beg Nov/Nov. XC only Round: Amoeba/Tadpole \$40 Beg Nov/Nov \$50. Hunter Pace Single: \$40 Singles/Pairs. Schooling only \$50.

AWARDS: 3-phase & XC Rounds: Pinned based on completion, refusals, and closest to optimum time. (Eventing Rules). **Hunter Pace:** Pinned on closes to optimum time. No jumping penalties.

JUMPS: Temporary fences will consist of Barrels, Brush Boxes, Tires, Coops, Ditches, Hay Bales, and possible Water Obstacle for Beg Nov & Nov. We have a blend of standard XC fences and stadium fences. Jumps may be sponsored and will be named after your farm/business. Water obstacle can/may be offered with sponsorship.

XC DIVISIONS: Amoeba 12” - Not timed but to be ridden walk/trot at 225 mpm; Tadpole 18” – 2’3” - To be ridden at 275 mpm; Beg Nov 2’6” To be ridden at 300 mpm; Nov 2’9” To be ridden at 350 mpm.

HUNTER PACE TRIAL: You guess the optimum time - closest one wins. Intended to be ridden slower than a XC course as if you on the trail or hunter trial. May be ridden in pairs or as a single. *Jumps optional* (no fault if you pass or try them as you please.) Wonderful opportunity to school your horse, friends to ride in pairs, or Mom and child to ride together.

PINNEYS: Bring your own pinney holder to receive your number. Available for sale. (Please email that you will need one). **VESTS:** Mandatory.

STABLING: 1 Night Sat noon til Sunday \$55. Two Night Fri-Sunday \$80. Grounds Fee \$40/day.

SATURDAY AYDC DRESSAGE & CT IMPORTANT INFO

RECOGNITION: GDCTA Schooling Show Recognized. AYDC Series End Championships.

AWARDS: Six ribbons per class. Special prizes as listed on front page. Dressage Seat Equitation classes qualify for the GDCTA Summer Show DSE Medal Finals with a 70 or above. Overall Dressage High Score and Low CT Score Awarded at each show. The Lisa Segar Insurance AA Medal Program **High Score AA for Training Level 3 Test. Designate AA on Entry Form!!!**

****RETURNING** YEAR END SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:** Awarded at October 6th show. Scores will be automatically counted, no additional entry necessary. Year End Series Champion Awards awarded for Junior/Adult riders within each division with the same horse & rider combinations for those attending 4 shows. Dressage will be recognized for Intro, Training, First & Above & must have 6 scores within the division to qualify with one score from each show of the 4 shows. If horse/rider combination are entered in more than 6 classes, the best 6 scores will be used. CT riders need at least 4 scores within the same following divisions: Pre-Amoeba, Amoeba, Tadpole, Beg Nov & Novice. Actual scores will be tabulated for Championship winner. USDF **Rider Test Challenge:** If four riders participate in **Training Level Rider Test** throughout the year, a High Score will be awarded. Show management reserves the right to modify rules as necessary.

CLOSING DATE: **Complete Packet needs to be in Secretary's hand by closing date or subject to late fee.** No Exceptions! Earn a Perfect Packet special treat! Partial entries received after closing date subject to late fee.

RIDE TIMES: Ride times will be available via email Thursday before each show.

ENTRIES: Entry Form, Payment, Current coggins within 12 months of show date, GDCTA Release. **All accepted entries are responsible for all fees.** Mail Entries: to AYDC 6715 Pirkle Dr. Cumming, GA 30028. Emailed entries accepted!

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$35 fee will be levied against any competitor whose check is returned from the bank (O.C. GA 16 -9-20).

PAYMENTS: Are \$ are due with entry. Emailed entries must provide a credit card or Pay Pal. Checks payable to Atlanta Youth Dressage Challenge (AYDC). We accept Visa & Mastercard - Must provide 3 digit security code. Indicate if name on card is different than rider! NON-COMPETE HORSES: Pay Stabling/Trailer In fee and Office fee. These horses must wear assigned bridle numbers.

POST ENTRIES/SUBSTITUTIONS: Entries after closing date are post entries and subject to a **\$20.00 post entry fee.** Rider or horse substitutions are allowed, but require a new entry and **\$10 change fee.** All other fees are transferred from the original entry.

REFUNDS: Scratches given in writing by Tuesday midnight prior to show: Full refund less office fee. After Tuesday, no refunds for any reason.

STABLING: Stabling is encouraged & is \$55 for day/overnight. Two nights stabling (Fri-Sun \$80) **Day-Trailer-ins must pay \$40/day except 3-phase entries pay one.** Please write your stabling requests (one name per group) on a Sticky Note or separate sheet and attach to entry form with map for large groups. The stalls have interlocking stall mats. We will be in Barn 5. All stalls have electricity, running water and steel doors. The dimensions of stalls in Barns 5 are 11'x12'; Your stall assignments will be posted on the Barn. Those wishing to stay over an extra night (Monday) must include an extra \$35 stabling fee. Farm animals are not allowed at the show. Tack stalls: \$30. Night check available *per request \$10.*

BEDDING AND GOLF CARTS: Queen Products now offers Curley shavings which may be purchased by calling Avery Harper at 770 -860-9111, or e-mail: queensalesgihp@gmail.com. Each stall comes with one bag of regular shavings. Straw bedding is not allowed— exceptions made only upon payment of an additional \$20 clean-up fee. Queen Wood Products also sells feed and rents golf carts. **FARRIER/VET BUILDING** is located near Barn 5, next to the building that houses the Queen Wood Products shavings office. Please tell the vet or farrier about this facility so that you can meet them there.

WHIPS: No whips longer than 47.2 inches in length including lash allowed in test OR Warm up.

DRESS: Formal attire encouraged (makes for better pictures right?!) but not mandatory. Polo shirts acceptable. No tee shirts. Half chaps are permitted. ASTM/SEI helmets mandatory when mounted and appropriate foot wear.

EMERGENCY NUMBERS: In case of emergency, call 911 or call the show manager at (770) 634-4089. The numbers of the show's veterinarian and farriers are published on the front of the show program and in prominent places at the facility.

THE CONCESSIONS STAND is open daily in the Walker Covered Arena from 7 a.m. till end of show.

ARENAS: Introductory Level Dressage, Amoeba thru Preliminary Combined Tests: Small dressage arena (20n x 40m). Training Level Dressage and up: Standard dressage arena (20m x 60m). Tests may be called. Warm Up, Jumping and Dressage is set up in the Rings 8, 9, &10. The entire area is surfaced with sand, all-weather footing that drains quickly in inclement weather. Schooling within the sides of competition arenas will be allowed on day before show.

COMBINED TESTS:

All USEF Dressage tests using the USEF 2015 tests. USEA 2018 Tests. **Dressage tests may be called for CT & 3-phase.**

SHOW JUMPING ROUNDS: May be used as schooling rounds. They will run immediately after finish of equivalent fence height CT division. **Show jump rounds are timed and pinned for all levels.**

DRESSAGE SEAT EQUITATION: 13 & under/14 & up. Classes immediately following lunch. Qualifying class for the GDCTA DSE Schooling Medal Final to be held at the GDCTA Summer Schooling Show in July 2016. Riders will walk, trot, & canter and be ridden on at Training Level/First Level.

MUSICAL FREESTYLE: Prefer flash drive media for music but contact show manager for other arrangements; Will perform right after lunch after Dressage Seat Equitation.

DIRECTIONS: Take Exit 82 from I-20. Turn North. The Georgia International Horse Park (GIHP), 1996 Centennial Olympic Parkway, Conyers, GA 30013, is located about 4 miles north of I-20 on GA Hwy. 138 (Exit 82). Centennial Olympic Parkway is on the right. Follow signs to main entrance on right. Trailers should take the third (most direct) park entrance—Gate D. Stabling uses Barn 5. Trailer/RV hookups will be on the left at end of RV lots. Show manager’s cell phone: (770) 634-4089.

Hawthorn Suites Hotel 1659 Centennial Olympic Parkway, Conyers, GA 30013, 770- 761-9155 (across from the park). They offer suites complete with mini-kitchen and separate bedroom. Other hotels: Days Inn at 770-922-3314; Hampton Inn 770-483-8838. **RV HOOK UPS** Camper and RV hook-ups are available at \$35 per night. There is a camper lot next to Barn 6. It has everything except sewer connections

COMPETITION “BRIDLE” NUMBERS: Show management requires that every horse on the grounds wear his/her competition number on the left side while the horse is out of his stall. This is mandatory!

THE SHOW OFFICE is in Barn 5 Day Before Show only from 2 to 6 p.m. Call show manager at (770) 634-4089 if you need assistance before or after then. Stalls will be unlocked for late arrivals. During the show, the office will be open from 7 a.m. till the show ends each competition day.

DOGS MUST BE LEASHED ON A LINE NO LONGER THAN SIX FEET. NO LOOSE DOGS!! Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. GR1301.6

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license, which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. GR1301.7

THE COMPETITION committee reserves the right to refuse or limit entries, to add or divide classes, to add or substitute judges or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications herein for the improvement of the competition. Entries will be accepted on a first-come basis before the closing date.
