Indoor environmental surfaces associated with children's activities, such as table tops, shall be cleaned and disinf OBSERVATION: 2 high chairs need cleaned and plastic high chair cover torn and needs replaced</p> <p>14.3 - All frequently touched toys in rooms in which infants and toddlers are cared for shall be cleaned and disinfected daily. Toys in rooms in which older, non-diapered children are cared for shall be cleaned weekly and when soiled. The use of soft, non-wash OBSERVATION: toys should be cleaned/sanitized on a scheduled basis</p>

14.4 - Toilet rooms, flush toilets, toilet training equipment, and fixtures shall be cleaned and sanitized at least daily and when obviously soiled.

OBSERVATION: restroom needs cleaned-walls, floor corners(urine odor), and ceiling vent--Toilet seat needs replaced(stained)

5.2.A - Floors, walls and ceilings shall be of easily cleanable construction.

OBSERVATION: playroom-floor perimeters need cleaned

5.3.F - All rooms used by children shall have a thermometer which shall be located approximately thirty (30) inches above floor level. Thermostats are not acceptable in lieu of thermometers.

OBSERVATION: window thermometers should be lowered to 30" from floor

6.1 - All activity equipment shall be free of safety hazards, shall be of smooth construction and, where applicable, easily cleanable. Activity equipment shall include, but not be limited to: toys, furnishings, tables, chairs, cots and similar equipment.

OBSERVATION: playground-end of swing set needs repaired(wooden splat)

9.9 - Toilet training chairs, if used, shall be of easily cleanable construction and after each use shall be emptied into a toilet, and thoroughly cleaned and sanitized in a utility sink.

OBSERVATION: underneath of potty seat needs cleaned thoroughly
