Mrs. Robert (Emma H. Mast) Kuhl, 72, Sebawaing, died Saturday at her home on North Center Street after a short illness.

She was born September 19, 1902 in Grand Rapids.

She and Robert Kuhl were married November 12, 1948 in Sebawaing.

Mrs. Kuhl was a former owner of the Mast Grocery Store in Sebawaing. She was in business for 20 years.

She was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church, Sebawaing, and a life member of the church's Ladies Aide and the Valporaisa University Guild. She was confirmed in Immanuel Lutheran Church April 16, 1916.

Formerly, she and Orvie H. Mast were married in November of 1920. Mr. Mast preceded his wife in death June 29, 1947.
