



Field Trip To A Crime Lab Simulation



Dear Parents,

On **Friday, April 27th**, we will take our **End-of-Year Academic, Behavior, and Attendance Field Trip**. We are going, first, to the **Louisiana Arts and Science Museum** to participate in a 90-minute **Crime Scene Simulation**. The 6th Grade will use the science of forensics to solve a crime. After we solve our crime, we will eat a picnic lunch on the levee, and watch the ships on the Mississippi River go by. Then, we will cross the street to the **Old State Capital** and take the tour. With our time all spent, we will board the school bus and get back to school before school ends.

The **cost of this field trip is \$6.75** for students and \$6.75 for parents. Students are required to ride the school bus to the event, but parents attending may check them out with Mrs. Olah or Mrs. Overton before we depart the Old State Capital.

We will depart at 7:50 to insure we get to the simulation on time. All students will need to bring a lunch. If you need the lunch room to provide one, please check the place down below. (Ms. Andre needs this information no later than April 11th, so field trip money must be paid by then.)

Please be advised that **all student fees must be paid before your child may attend**. This is our End-of-Year Academic, Behavior, and Attendance Trip. Only students with good behavior all year, passing grades, and acceptable attendance is eligible to attend. For questions on eligibility, please contact Mrs. Blount in the office.
