Revelation 6:1–2 — "¹ Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." ² I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer."

- I. "White Horse" Did John see a real horse and rider or just a symbol of it?
 - A. **Viewpoints:** Some say that it refers to the Anti-Christ, or refers to the return of Christ,
 - B. **Deeper search of the Bible:** shows that there are many white horses used by heaven.
 - 1. Jesus will come down on a white horse for the battle of Armageddon (Rev 19).
 - 2. The armies that will following Him ride on white horses **Revelation 19:14**
 - C. The visions of Zachariah contained horses:
 - 1. The Lord sends them to patrol the earth Zechariah 1:8-11
 - 2. The horses are described as spirits that stand before the Lord. **Zechariah 6:1–5**
 - 3. These spirits can also execute God's judgement over regions of the earth **Zechariah 6:7–8**
 - D. **Interpretation:** So if the four horses of the apocalypse are the same kind of horses that the prophet Zechariah saw, then the horsemen of the apocalypse are also spiritual beings released to execute God's judgments on earth for the end times.
- II. "And he who sat on it had a bow" What is the meaning of the bow?
 - A. The bow has decided the battle with a single arrow:

 - A. Crown indicates that the rider has authority and sovereignty.
- **IV.** "And he went out conquering and to conquer." What did this horseman go out to conquer?
 - A. We know that it is not military conquest. That's what the red horseman will do (see Rev 3:3-4).
 - B. There other kinds of warfare: information warfare?
 - 1. It could be Psychological operations (Psy-Ops)
 - a. **Meaning:** these involves the planned use of propaganda and other psychological operations to influence the opinions, emotions, attitudes, and behavior of opposition groups.
 - C. **Possible Interpretation:** The white horse rider could be waging psychological operations to prepare the world for judgment.
 - 1. Example: God used angels to do a **Psy-Ops** against King Ahab: 2 Chronicles 18:19–21
- V. Lesson for the End Times:
 - A. We need to take care not to be deceived along with the world.
 - 1. Jesus says to His disciple, "Let no one mislead you" -Matt 24:4
 - B. Study the word of God so you don't get mislead.
 - 1. Be involved in the bible studies of your church.
