

CHILDREN'S CLASSES

CWDA with the support of WDA, conducts 10-12 children's pilot classes that teach literacy and basic mathematics to 30 children in each class, each semester. This Pilot Class provides basic medical supplies, lunch, uniforms, shoes and school supplies to approximately 130 children. CWDA provides an educational opportunity that otherwise would not come for children living in slums on the outskirts of town, or in rural communities. It is especially valuable for the girls in these communities, as they would never be allowed to attend otherwise. Due to familial poverty, the climate of the culture, and lack of availability, girls are the last priority for education in poor communities. They are much more valuable as domestic or factory workers.
