14 Now after John was arrested, Jesus came to Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God, 15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news." Mark 1:14-15

Wow, it seems hard to believe we are already inside of February! We are well into the time after Epiphany where we are studying what it means to *Follow Jesus*. Each Sunday in Epiphany, we explore and see proof of Jesus's invitation.

Only 14 verses into Mark's gospel and we read these two verses. These two verses are the heart of Mark's gospel. Mark tells of Jesus' purpose and determination to share the good news of God. Jesus's purpose and determination should translate to OUR purpose and determination:

Share the Gospel!

As we share the Gospel, the first chapter in Mark might give you some language as you share the gospel with others.

- We invite others as Jesus invites us.
- We learn a new catch as Jesus teaches us to fish.
- We teach with authority as Jesus is the authority.

- Pastor Gina: Written report received. Robert and Joy Haygood to join church (Marion Leaphart's sister).
- Treasurer: Written report received for November 2020
- Financial Secretary: Written report received for November 2020 to present

Team Reports/Recommendations:

- 1. Worship: Written report received from December 7th meeting. Council member requests considering two Christmas Eve services for 2021.
- 2. Outreach: Distributed 42 Thanksgiving meals. A successful Free Garage Sale helped 35 families. Angel Tree was able to distribute presents to 36 individuals. Committee thanks everyone who contributed to each event and/or volunteered. Food Pantry will also distribute Christmas meals.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Cross on Sanctuary: Signtech currently building cross.
- 2. Health & Safety Task Force: Written report received from December 10th meeting. We are currently seating members every third pew in sanctuary with maximum capacity of 50 members. We could change seating to every other pew allowing 80 members in sanctuary. We cannot use the fellowship hall for overflow because of inadequate ventilation. Motion to approve increasing church capacity to 80 members.

APPROVED

3. Teach team: Children Focus of sermon at the December 20th service

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Church Council election: Members voted to add Blake Allen, Mike Rawl, Sheila Starkey, Allison Swygert, and Jackson Price. Members who completed their 3-year term were thanked for their service: Ann Addy, Diane Boulware, Devona Price, Alyson Price, and Mitch Stevens.
- 2. Christmas/Advent/Epiphany offering: Motion to approve designating offerings in these envelopes be given to food pantry. **APPROVED**
- 3. Vacation pay: Pastor Gina and Ruthie Brannon both worked thru their vacation time due to extenuating circumstances of COVID and live streaming startup. Motion to pay them their regular salary for those days and not at a substitute's rate as a one-time situation. Ruthie would receive \$807 and Pastor Gina \$3000. Parker would be allowed to take from church funds based on his discretion to cover the overage. **APPROVED**
- 4. Election of Church Council officers: All current positions were voted to continue for 2021. President: Ronnie Fulmer, Vice President: Marion Leaphart, Secretary: Robin Ellisor, Treasurer: Parker Boulware, and Financial Secretary: Annette Price.
- 5. Next council meeting will be January 10th with devotions by Marion Leaphart. Council will be installed at church on December 20th.

Outreach happenings . . .

Food Pantry – God has used our Food Pantry ministry to assist so many this year. We provided **874** "setups" of food in 2020. Each "setup" consists of groceries totaling about **\$20**. That means that Mt. Hermon disciples along with community groups such as Boy Scouts, Pineview Ruritan Club, Woodmen of

the World and Thrivent Financial have provided **\$17,480** of food for families in our community. The Food Pantry runs solely by donations and is not part of the church budget. In addition, we also distributed 40 Thanksgiving and 40 Christmas bags which contained food for a ham dinner

and dessert. The quantity of food in these bags varied depending on the size of the family. **Current Needs** - We have recently had several requests for **diapers**, for both **children** and **adults**. We will welcome any size that you have to donate.



Meals on Wheels – Mt. Hermon participates in Lexington County Commission on Aging's Meals on Wheels program. Jean Shealy and James Hallman chair this ministry at Mt. Hermon. Mt. Hermon has four teams which take turns distributing meals to the elderly each Wednesday.

Facemask Ministry – Mt. Hermon disciples have sewn and donated over **500** handmade facemasks for members of the community. These masks are given to anyone in need of a facemask. There is no way of knowing how many lives have been saved through this ministry.

Little Free Library –There are books for all ages in our Little Free Library. Please come at your leisure to check-out the books available. We change the books in the Library every week or so. People can borrow, donate, exchange or keep the books in the Little Free Library. It is a world-wide book sharing program to promote literacy and community unity.





ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY Mt. Hermon continues to help keep Leaphart Road clean by participating in the Adopt-a-Highway program. Tom Stahl chairs this ministry at Mt. Hermon. Please consider helping at our next pickup, **February 20.** We meet in the church parking lot at 9:00. Caring for our environment is part of our responsibility as God's stewards.

Free Garage Sale – Thank you for your donations to the annual Free Garage Sale. We had thirty-four people "shop" our event. Even though their "shopping time" was limited to ten-fifteen minutes, the participants were able to find many items they needed. The people who came were very appreciative of all that they received. The items that were left after the event were donated to His House because the Salvation Army was closed due to

COVID 19. A special thanks to some of Mt. Hermon's Boy Scouts and their families for packing the leftover items and taking them to His House.








