It was moved by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Fite to adopt the ordinance. All present voted yea. Motion Carried.


It was moved by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Melendez to adopt the emergency clause. All present voted yea. Motion Carried.

STATE OF AMELIA

Amelia has had another great year.

As of January 1, 2017 there was a carryover of \$178,355.27. There were a couple of add-ons to this amount after January 1, 2017 of projects from 2016. All major funds produced a carryover from 2016.

The general fund now sits at \$221,386.57.

In 2016 Dollar Tree opened its doors which employs around 10 people.

Also as of December 2016 Kroger is up to approximately 380 employees with 40% being full time.

We have started on the annexation of approximately 49 acres and Premier Heath Care is building a 15 million dollar complex that will employ around 200-225 people.

We purchased the corner of Lori Lane for future expansion of the intersection and to bring new economic growth to Amelia.

Phases 8, 9 and 10 in Amelia Park has taken off with new houses and Woodside Park is following suit in completing their phases and bringing in new Town Houses with Drees.

All in all the Village continues to move forward and is and will exceed its goal of 5,000 residents and be Clermont County's next new city.
