Policies Full Year Classes



These policies were designed to insure the best possible classroom experience for your student.

--Students should have a notebook and something to write with for their online class. Some of their work will be done online, and some work done by hand. Students must also have their textbook and course outline for each class.

--Calculators are not permitted in Arithmetic, Prealgebra and Algebra I.

--Students must have their textbooks ready by the first day of class. Students without books will immediately be lost.

--Computer microphones are very sensitive. Please keep background noise to a minimum.

--Payment must be received in order to hold your spot. Financing options are available. Space is limited.

--Payments received after 30 days are subject to a late fee. No refunds can be given after classes start.

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--Inevitably, students will have to miss a class. The reason could be sickness, travel conflicts, technical issues, and internet problems. In the event of a missed class, parents must schedule a mandatory make up session to go over the missed material.

--Students that struggle excessively have the option to switching to an easier class or receive extra help one-on-one from a teacher.

--One-on-one tutoring sessions and makeup sessions are invoiced at the rate of \$30 / hr. Makeup sessions can be as short as 15 minutes.

--Tests and quizzes must be turned in on time. Students are not be allowed to return to class until the tests and quizzes are turned in.

--Parents must proctor exams correctly. Instructions are included with each test and quiz.

--Parents must check email regularly for emails from SLC, and respond to them as quickly as possible.

--Keep an eye on your student. If students drift off, get distracted, or are not paying attention, they can fall behind.
