A few important things to note:

Pickets MUST be No. 2 or better Western Red Cedar. Posts, stringers, and rot board may be pressure treated pine.

***Fence segments that make the perimeter of Section 4 along Philippine, Gessner, Mauna Loa and Windfern must be replaced with an 8' fence segment made up of a 12" rot board and 7' pickets.**
