Working Equitation in my opinion is the best cross training you can do for any horse. As long as you are doing it correctly. Don't rush, take your time, keep your horse relaxed at all costs. Pushing only makes your horse tense and unhappy. If you continue on that path you will end up with soundness problems. Slow, relaxed and steady is the way to go.
