Dear Friend of Bay County Fair & Youth Exposition:

This year's fair is right around the corner and the Bay County Fair and Youth Exposition is growing by leaps and bounds. The number of projects entered at fair is continually increasing, and that's no exception for our horse and livestock projects. Over the past 3 years, the number of horse entries has increased by 37% and the number of Livestock entries has increased by 15%.

The Bay County Fair and Youth Exposition Board recognizes the need for new roofs on the horse and livestock barns and 28 new stall fronts for the horse barn. Today we are asking for sponsorships for those roofs and stall fronts. The improvements we need for the barns are costly, and although the Bay County Fair and Youth Exposition Board is pro-actively fundraising, financial help is still needed.

Sponsorship Options Include:

- Horse Stall Front-Full: \$500
 - Includes exclusive large personalized plaque on one of the updated stall fronts.
- Horse Stall Front-Half: \$250

- Horse or Livestock Barn Roof-Gold: \$500

- Horse or Livestock Barn Roof-Silver: \$250
 - Includes medium personalized plaque on Sponsor Board in horse or livestock barn.
- Horse or Livestock Barn Roof-Bronze: \$100
 - Includes small personalized plaque on Sponsor Board in horse or livestock barn.
