AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS: STRUCTURED TEACHING MODEL LEVEL II

This advanced STM training is intended for practitioners who have attended basic 3 or 5 day STM-TEACCH training and who have consistently and effectively implemented STM principals of visual organization, physical structure, schedules, work systems and tasks. Demonstrated proficiency in instruction and management of student with autism spectrum disorders is required. Training will consist of lectures, demonstrations, analysis, discussion of video examples, and application of skills, Participants may submit DVD copies of problematic situations for use in group discussions for problem solving (FERPA applies). Program outcomes include:

- ❖ Learn, discuss and devise strategies for problem-solving autism-related issues in behavior, communication, and social skills
- ❖ Practice informal assessments to determine IEP goals/objectives
- ❖ Use various strategies to monitor student progress toward IEP goals/objectives
- ❖ Plan meaningful social inclusive activities
- ❖ Devise strategies for meaningful inclusion in typical classrooms
- ❖ Learn how to teach students to problem-solve social situations
- ❖ Learn, discuss and devise strategies for improving parental collaboration
