It worked out for many of you, as over half of the 92 players shot net par or better. Pace of play was very good, as I'm sure nobody took very long to choose a club.

Thanks to those who filled the tip jar for the El Prado staff. This allows us to show our appreciation to the golf staff who take care of us all year long.

A special thank you goes out those members who never request anything special. Most of the time preparing pairings and tee times is spent reviewing requests. We understand some requests are necessary, and we do our best to satisfy them, but you can't always have your favorite foursome. We also like to mix new members in with established members, so that they feel welcome, and have somebody around to answer questions about the club or rules. So you can see why those who say "put me at any time with anybody" sure make our job easier.

By now we hope you are getting used to the event web site https://www.golfgenius.com/ggid/epmc, which is a directory of our tournaments and skins games. The easiest way to reach this is to pick the Events link on the club website. You should not be prompted for a password or GGID. Once on the events directory page, scroll down and pick the TITLE of the tournament or skins game – don't pick View or Results. When the next page comes up, you can select Tee Sheets or Results. If you are not seeing our events, try clearing any filters.

If you want to see details, try picking on a golfer name, or picking Expand All for the Skins. You can see hole by hole scores for every player.

The TOP 25 is back, and the results from the first three tournaments are shown below. We are showing the total only, which comes from the Player Purse Summary for each tournament. If you want to see the breakdown of scrip, skins, and closest, you need to look at the individual tournament results.

The 2021 Tournament Schedule has been published on the web site and in this newsletter. Plan your calendar now so that you don't miss out on anything! The formats are the same, but some dates have shifted to avoid the aeration schedule. Due to popular request, those wanting to compete for the low gross Club Champion will now play three rounds. The extra round will be the Friday between the two Saturday rounds.

January's tournament is a 2 Man Better Ball. Partners are limited to a maximum 8 stroke difference in course handicap. You are welcome to sign up with a partner, or if you don't have one, sign up as a single and we will pair you up with somebody in your handicap range. Signup by January 9 by emailing Doug at dbenc@ap.org.

Remember that tee sheets and results are available in the Events link https://www.golfgenius.com/ggid/epmc on our web site without a password. Once on the events page, scroll down and pick the TUESDAY SKINS or SATURDAY SKINS title. When the next page comes up, you can select Tee Sheets or Results. You should see the latest week, but you can also change the date to see previous weeks.

If you have any questions about the results, you can pick any player name to see hole by hole scores. You can also pick on Expand All to see the scoring details. For example, want to know who cut you on a hole? It's all there with a couple clicks.

- In 4 flight events, A plays blue tees; B plays white tees on Chino Creek or blue tees on Butterfield Stage; C plays white tees.
- 2 Man team events are pick your partner, maximum 8 stroke handicap difference.
- Course Handicap for tournaments is based on the index of the previous Wednesday.
