**2. 2024 WALKERTOWN FALL FESTIVAL UPDATE**

We have 80 vendors coming so far. That is 8 vendors ahead of last year.

There are 37 Arts & crafts vendors, 16 information/no sales booths, 11 direct sales vendors like Tupperware and 31 gifts. Food vendors are the Civic Club, Girls Softball, Delicias Xpress, Street Corn, Funnel Cake truck, cotton candy & candied apples, Little Donut truck.
