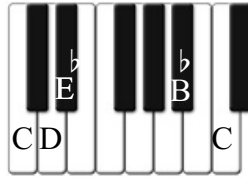

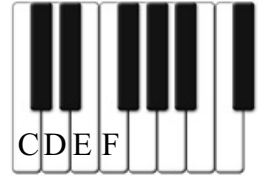

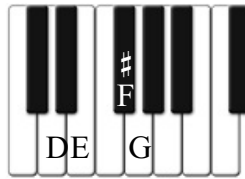


Tetrachord with D
as the 2nd note

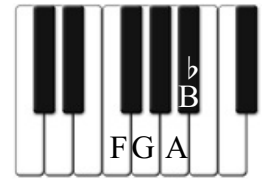

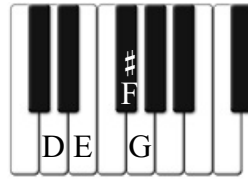


Tetrachord with B \flat
as the last note

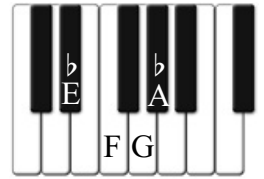


D E F \sharp G F G A B \flat

as the 3rd note

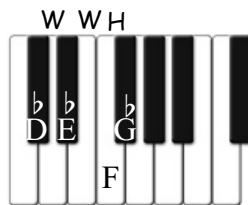


Tetrachord with F

as the last note




Tetrachord with C \flat
as the last note






