




Why Worship?

So, don't miss the beauty and blessing of weekly worship!







Elizabeth River District Conference -October 20, 2018 Update


At the Elizabeth River District Conference, held on October 20, 2018, District Superintendent Wayne Snead cast a vision for the Elizabeth River District. Recognizing that the local church and local ministries are on the front line of making disciples who are lifelong learners who influence others to serve, the District seeks to assist the laity and clergy to accomplish the mission given by God.

The first of the three strategies is <u>"Empowering."</u> The District is committed to providing laity and clergy with high-quality training that is practical, usable, and hands-on. Examples include Connect, Breakthrough Prayer, and District Training Day with leadership from the General Board of Discipleship.

The second strategy is "Equipping." Training events are great, but in addition to that, the District is committed to working with laity and clergy within the context of their congregation. The focus shifts from events to equipping within the congregation's context of ministry. Examples include Next Level Innovations and Shift.

The final strategy is <u>"Planting."</u> While there have been restarts and mergers on the District, there will be a renewed emphasis on planting new faith communities. The Elizabeth River District Board of Missions, Inc. along with the District Building and Location and the New Faith Community Task Force, will survey the District considering new and fresh ways to do church, with or without a building.

Email Issues

The church office has recently encountered several problems with many of our members not receiving emails sent from the church office from both Joyce and Cindy. Or not receiving them in a timely manner. After spending much time on the phone w/Cox Communications troubleshooting the problem, their recommendations to alleviate these issues are as follows:

- 1. Check to make sure your spam filter has not "flagged" any correspondence from Aldersgate specifically (joyce@aldersgateumcnorfolk.hrcoxmail.com or director@aldersgateumcnorfolk.hrcoxmail.com).
- 2. If it's checked as Spam, you will not see any email from the church office and you will need to disable this feature or else all email will go to Spam instead of your "Inbox".
- 3. Routinely <u>check your email!</u> Several people have too many emails or don't check their messages regularly and it is causing a problem especially with Cox.Net recipients. (Apparently this is a glitch associated primarily with Cox customers but could apply to other users as well-sometimes yahoo or gmail). Several browsers have updated recently. Just deleting your messages from your inbox is not enough—you have to empty your trash bin also.
- 4. For those messages you desire to save, create a folder or folders under your Inbox to sort and save your emails to i.e. business mail, online orders, etc. This will free up space.
- 5. If you don't read or check your messages on a regular basis, please let the office know as this is creating a problem with kicked back/not delivered emails resulting in other church members not receiving what could be important messages
