<u>Water project update</u> Trinity is still working on Spanish Valley Drive, a change order was approved to connect services to a four-inch hdpe line and remove abandoned pipe. Weather delays have caused the final date to extend to August 12th. Work on Roberts Road starts Monday. Dana mailed a letter to residents reminding them to keep children away from any equipment and that the street will be closed to thru traffic. Roberts Road should be smoother than Spanish valley drive because there is less traffic and more room to work. The tank has been poured and almost ready for the lid. This part of the project should be complete around the end of the month. The committee have been working on phase II of the project and have asked Devan Shields to start working on the application to Rural Development.

<u>Discussion and approval of five-year financial services proposal from Smuin, Rich and Marsing</u> Motion to approve the five-year financial services proposal from Smuin, Rich and Marsing by Dale Weiss. Second by Preston Paxman. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

<u>Lake/Snow report – the lake is 476 AF, SWE is 161% of average and Precipitation is 155% of average. Soil moisture is at 40%. There are storms forecasted to bring more snow to the mountains and rain to the valley. Irrigation system start up is delayed until more water is in the lake and the weather turns warmer.</u>

Committee report the committee has not met.

<u>Items from staff</u> Dana met with Matt from RCAC and they have been going over numbers for the culinary water study and these findings should be discussed next board meeting. Dana went to a meeting with the Moab Area Water Shed partnership. A \$40,000 program study showing drought resilience plan was highlighted and they are seeking \$1500 from 5 different entities. A proposal will be brought to the board soon.
