PHILADELPHIA 24 San Francisco 21.**

By far the two best teams in the NFC this season square off here and you can make a case that these are the two best rosters in the NFL. San Francisco makes their 2nd straight NFC Championship game and 3rd in 4 years under Shanahan. It's incredibly their 15th NFC Championship game since their first Super Bowl season of 1981. The 49ers have won 12 straight games (10-2 ATS) coming into this match-up. Last week's opponent Dallas was arguably the toughest team San Francisco has faced in that stretch and it was a struggle for the 49ers offense. After averaging 34.6 ppg in their previous 7 starts under rookie Brock Purdy, the 49ers only scored 19 points vs the Cowboys. The 49ers OL struggled early with the Dallas defensive front and now face a Philly team that incredibly had 70 sacks this year (15 more than anyone else). Philadelphia is making their first NFC Championship game since 2017 and this is their 7th appearance since 1980. The Eagles dominated the Giants last week 38-7 and regained some of that mojo that led them to their 13-1 SU start. It helped that Jalen Hurts looked 100% for the first time in a month. These two teams played the easiest schedules in the NFL this regular season (according to DVOA and Jeff Sagarin) so this will be the toughest test yet for both young QB's. The young QB that avoids the costly mistake(s) will likely determine the winner. Both QB's have so many weapons around them and both coaches do a brilliant job spreading the ball around to their many play-makers. Philly has a pair of 1,000-yard receivers in AJ Brown and DeVonta Smith along with a 1,000-yard rusher in Miles Sanders. Meanwhile, San Fran has RB Christian McCaffrey, TE George Kittle, All-everything Deebo Samuel and WR Brandon Aiyuk. The 49ers have a positive TO differential in 10 straight games, that's the longest streak in the NFL since the 2000 Baltimore Ravens. However, Purdy's first road play-off start against that aggressive Eagles' defense could have that streak coming to an end. This is an extremely tough call as we like both teams and the market is super sharp on this game. We will defer to our advantage teaser play (also called a Wong teaser) that has been very good to us on these pages all year (40-8 on teaser legs!). The tease is to take the underdog 49ers up through key numbers of "3" and "7".

KANSAS CITY 24 Cincinnati 23.**

For the 2nd straight season these two teams meet in the AFC Championship game. Cincinnati pulled the shocking upset last year in Kansas City as 7-point underdogs. The Bengals finished last season covering their final 8 games and are on a 13-3 ATS run coming into this game this season (13-1 vs non-Baltimore teams). They pulled off another shocker last week by dominating the Bills on the road from start to finish 27-10 (+6). It was one of the more impressive performances by any team in any game this season. It was shocking considering the Bengals were down 3 starting offensive lineman and still ran at will on the Bills. However, the Bengals were just No. 13 in ypp margin this year and should have lost outright to Baltimore the previous week. We think the market may have upgraded them a little too much especially considering they were 2.5-point home underdogs to KC back in December and both teams have won 6 straight games since. On the other side, Kansas City is hosting the AFC Championship for a 5th straight year (NFL-record). KC head coach Andy Reid also coached in 4 straight NFC Championship back in his Philadelphia days (5 overall). The Chiefs do have an extra day to prep here and played the early game last Saturday. However, QB Patrick Mahomes suffered a high ankle sprain vs Jacksonville and will not be close to 100% for this game. Burrow's Bengals are 3-0 SU/ATS vs Mahomes' Chiefs the last two years. However, Warren Sharp pointed out that the Chiefs have led by 18, 14 and 7 points in these games. KC has never trailed entering the 4th quarter, have trailed for an average of only 15 minutes each game and have trailed for an average of only 7:52 in each second half. So you could say the Bengals are very fortunate to be 3-0 vs the Chiefs. If Mahomes has any mobility, KC has value as a home underdog. If he doesn't have any, then this number makes sense with the Bengals favored. We will once again defer to our advantage teaser play (also called a Wong teaser) that has been very good to us on these pages all year (40-8 on teaser legs!). The tease is to take the underdog Chiefs up through key numbers of "3" and "7".
