African Bubinga riser. Comfortable grip. The 64" length makes it a smooth and comfortable bow to shoot. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is a reproduction. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed.) Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
