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Patient Care Technician II

[CNA, Phlebotomy, and Dialysis]

Prestige Nurse Aide Training Academy is excited about the idea of combining 3 of our highly favored programs in modules over a 20 week time frame. This program has been approved by The Illinois Board of Higher Education Private Business and Vocational School Division (IBHE), and The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH)

- ❖ **The First Module** of the Patient Care Technician II Program starts with the CNA Course. During this module, the basis of Communication, Patient Care, Bedside Manner, Infection Control, Medical Terminology, Vital Signs, Calculation of Intake and Output, Collecting Specimens (Urine, Feces, Sputum), Reporting Observations, HIPAA, Patients Rights, and Legalities will be covered. The State Certification Exam for Certified Nursing Assistant will also be taken.
- ❖ **The Second Module** will start Phlebotomy Technician: This module will reinforce Patient Identification, Communication, Patients Rights, HIPAA, and Medical Terminology. Anatomy and Physiology will be covered with emphasis on the Circulatory and Vascular Systems. The components of blood, coagulation/anticoagulation, order of draw and additives, handling specimens, labeling, and proper techniques identifying veins and addressing difficult veins. The students will adhere to the Phlebotomy Technician grading scale and mandated requirement of 25 successful Veinpunctures and 25 Capillary sticks. A separate national certification may be taken after this module if the student chooses to become a Nationally Certified Phlebotomy Technician (NCPT).
- ❖ **The Third Module** in the Patient Care Technician II Program is Renal Dialysis Technician. Students will be empowered with Basic knowledge as they learn about the working units of the kidneys as more Anatomy and Physiology of the renal system is covered. Students will learn about End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) and possible causes. Various options of Dialysis Treatment, including Peritoneal vs Hemodialysis are covered, along with variants in patient access device choices. Students will learn how to maintain the dialysis machine during the approximate 4 hour treatment. Students are also taught how to monitor patient stability including taking vital signs. Water Treatments as well as understanding the Working Components of a Dialysis machines are illustrated with return demonstration lab. Infection Control practices are reinforced. Renal Diets and Preventative Health Diagnosis are discussed to maintain optimal Kidney Function. A Dialysis Technician Certificate of Completion will accompany the student upon successful completion



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After completion of this program students will have positive outcomes in their employment search as Dialysis Patient Care Technicians in renal Dialysis Centers.
