

In Photography 102 students will add to their skills learned in Photography 101, adding to the basics and fundamentals of photography. They will learn and explore the inner mechanical workings of a DSLR (digital single-lens reflex) camera. They will learn what the elements of aperture, shutter speed, and ISO are and how to make them work together to create images. Students will also learn how to recognize good lighting, and take advantage of natural light to help create beautiful images.

The class will have opportunities to put their skills to practice through out the school year. Some projects will be aimed to provide content for the yearbook.

Students will be required to have access to a DSLR Camera (Canon Preferred).
