

Pat Reid Baby Quilt Contest

Pat Reid was a beloved member of the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. who passed away in 2013. Her love of quilting was mainly dedicated to the making of baby quilts and she chaired the Lullaby Baby Quilt Committee for the Guild for many years. On May 8, 2013 the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. established the Pat Reid Baby Quilt Contest. Prizes and Awards will be presented to the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. member who's baby quilt was selected from those quilts entered in the contest. The Winners will be announced at the April's General Membership meeting.

This year a separate award will be given for using a pattern from Pat Reid's Pattern Booklet.

Requirements are:

- All techniques accepted: pieced, appliqued, embroidery.
- The finished quilt should be no smaller than 36" x 36" and no larger than 40" x 54"
- Members may enter as many completed quilts as they desire
- The Guild will not provide any fabric and/or supplies for the quilt
- Quilt must be received by the deadline or it will not be eligible to be judged

The quilts will be displayed, and the winner announced at the Business Meeting, Following the close of the contest.

Quilts will become property of Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. and be distributed in accordance with the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc. goals and objectives when the Contest is completed.
