## THE BIG PICTURE; FRAMED BY GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

Athletic events are learning experiences for student-athletes. Some audiences may forget that high school athletes have not reached mature physical performance, so errors can be expected. Good sportsmanship applies as much to athletes as it does to parents and all spectators. Good sportsmanship results when participants and spectators:

- Show respect for the opposing players, coaches, fans and support groups and treat them as they would treat a guest in their own home.
- Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials. Understand that officials are doing their best to help promote the student-athlete and admire their willingness to participate in full view of the public.
- Remember that they are at a contest to support and cheer for their team and to enjoy the skill and competition, not to intimidate or ridicule the other team and its fans.
- Remember that interscholastic athletics are learning experiences for students
  and that mistakes are sometimes made. Praise student athletes as they attempt
  to improve themselves as students, as athletes and as people just as one would
  praise a student working in the classroom.
- Learn the rules of the game so they understand and appreciate why certain situations take place.
- Remember that a ticket to an interscholastic athletic event is a privilege to observe the contest, not a license to verbally assault others and be obnoxious.

- Refrain from taunting or making any kind of derogatory remarks to opponents during the game.
- Recognize and show appreciation for an outstanding play by either team.
- Use only those cheers that support and uplift the teams involved.
- Appreciate and support the efforts of school and league administrators to emphasize the benefits of educational athletics and the role of good sportsmanship.
- Are positive behavior role models through their own actions and by censuring those around them at events where behavior is unbecoming.







