## From the President's Desk:

The board has approved two by-law changes which will be voted on as part of the official ballot at the May election:

1. We would like to simplify the dues structure for people joining the club. The current by-laws call for adding time to the membership and pro-rating the current year's dues. The proposed bylaw would make the cost of joining our club \$185 (\$110 dues and \$75 initiation) all year long. 
# **Fundraising:**
