Trustees Corner

Here's an update about our moving progress

Welcome to the Trustees Corner. It's been a while since The Trustees have written and we wanted to give you an update on several things.

MOVING ALONG SLOWLY

First on everyone's mind is the move to the new building. Things have been moving slower than we would like. This is due to several things that we have little control over, such as permitting and inspections.

The other is money. During this process there are many things that Sound Transit is responsible to either pay for or reimburse the Eagles for. The issue comes when that payment or reimbursement takes several weeks or months to come to fruition. The Aerie doesn't have the financial resources to plunk down tens of thousands of dollars of its own money for large purchases for the new building and as such, we must wait for monies to come in from Sound Transit before we can purchase services or equipment.

LARGE EXPENSES

One such large expense is the new kitchen. In order to make the large purchase of equipment, we need to wait on a substantial payment from Sound Transit. With this process in mind, we are making steady progress. We still hope to be in the new building by the end of November, but have made provisions with Sound Transit for the end of January, 2020.

DRINK PRICE INCREASE

With the costs of products and labor increasing, the Trustees felt it was necessary to raise alcohol, not beer, prices by \$.50. We do not do this easily, but felt it was necessary to help keep the cash flow of the Aerie positive. The Puyallup Eagles is still one of the cheapest places in town to have a cold drink and

relax with your friends. We hope you understand the increase.

COOK, BOOKKEEPER NEEDED

The Aerie is currently, and for a long time, in need of another cook. If any of the members have friends or friends of friends who would like to make some extra money by expressing their culinary talents, please contact Loni. The Aerie is also looking for a new bookkeeper. Again contact Loni if there is any interest.

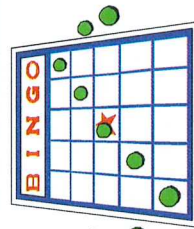

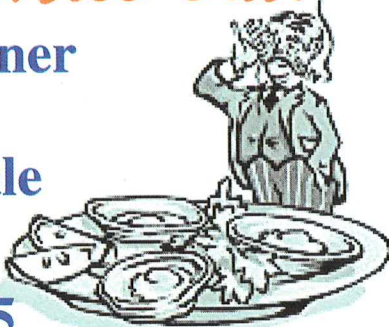
