



Scholarship Mission Statement

The objective of the Lion's Club is to make a difference both on a local as well as national level. So the goal of the scholarship is to help students reach the next step of their educational experience, while encouraging them to perform community service.

Lions Club Scholarship

- Scholarship is worth \$500.00
- Criteria
 - Full time student at West Geauga Local Schools.
 - Participated in the Lion's Club program for a year, either as a player, cheerleader, or other positions.
 - Must have a cumulative 2.80 GPA or higher, and maintain the GPA throughout your senior year.
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - One is required from a teacher and the other is from a person or group that you provided community service for.
 - Must provide community service through other organizations or the Lion's club.
 - Must acquire 20hrs of community service through the participant's start of academic year, till December 31st. the participant's senior year in high school.
- Essay
 - If eligible for the scholarship you must provide a 750 or less worded essay answering the following questions.
 - What is community service to you? How will you continue to provide community service through college and with your chosen profession?
 - 12 point font, Times Roman, double or single space, must have a title for the essay.
- The board of directors will limit the applicants for the scholarship to 3. After the applicant are limited to 3 people the club will then vote for the winning applicant.
 - If you're on the board and have a child participating for the scholarship then you cannot partake in the decision process until the club votes on the winning applicant.
- In order to receive the scholarship from the Lion's Club, the winner must present us with a letter of enrollment to the college of their choice. This way we are reassured that the recipient of the scholarship is attending college. If the winner is unable to provide a letter of enrollment then the runner up will have the opportunity to acquire the scholarship.

Lions Club Vocational Scholarship

- Scholarship is worth \$500.00
- Criteria
 - Full time student at West Geauga Local Schools.
 - You don't have to acquire a part time job in the trade that you are going to school for.
 - Participated in the Lion's Club program for a year, either as a player, cheerleader, or other positions.
 - Must have a cumulative 2.80 GPA or higher, and maintain the GPA throughout your senior year.
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - One is required from a teacher and the other is from a person or group that you provided community service for.
 - Must provide community service through other organizations or the lions club.
 - Must acquire 20hrs of community service through the participant's start of academic year, till December 31st. the participant's senior year in high school.
- Essay
 - If eligible for the scholarship you must provide a 750 or less worded essay answering the following questions.
 - What is community service to you? How will you continue to provide community service through college and with your chosen profession?
 - 12 point font, Times Roman, double or single space, must have a title for the essay.
