We had a great crowd and a barn full of good horses. The top seller was \$60,000, the top ten average was \$34,450 and the top 20 average was \$26,225. Hats off to Dewayne and the crew for putting on a great sale. The construction project here at TLA will now kick into high gear! Our goal of completing this project by September 1st is possible, but there is a lot to be done between now and then. Our restaurant will also have to be closed on the weekends for a while as well while we install a new HVAC system.
