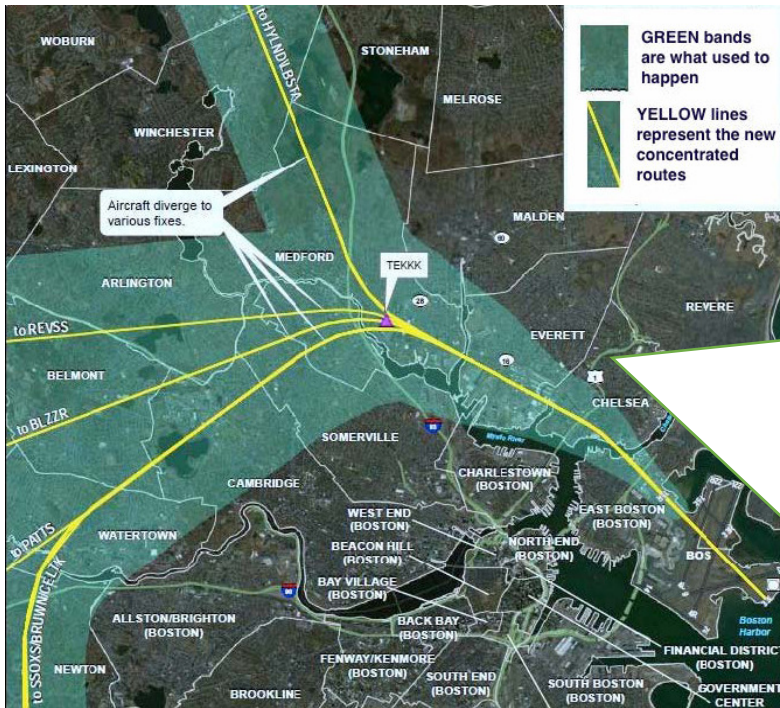




Too Much Airplane Noise?

The FAA changed (06/05/2013) departure procedures at Logan's runway (RW) 33L. Narrow RNAV paths (GPS vs. radar) – "Highways in the Sky" are now being used. On W & NW winds days EVERY plane departing from RW 33L flies on one of the four narrow RNAV paths over specific neighborhoods. It sometimes amounts to hundreds of planes/day, every 2 minutes or less, over the same neighborhoods - directly over your home. The magnitude of **dwel and persistence** is unfair. We are fighting for **Fair Skies**.
