## **Experience Louisiana Festival**

The main stage will showcase great Louisiana talent. Bands include: Cypress Band featuring Warren Storm and Willie Tee, Cha Wa Mardi Gras Indian Funk Band (New Orleans), High Performance, Sabra & The Get Rights, The Band Courtbouillon and closing the festival will be Wayne Toups. Eunice is home to the internationally acclaimed Rendez Vous des Cajun Radio Show, held at the Liberty Theater on Saturday nights. A highlight of the festival will be the broadcasting of the October 22 show live from the festival grounds. The Geno Delafose & French Rockin' Boogie will be featured band on the program.

The festival formally opens at 10:00am Saturday and 10:30am Sunday. However, Saturday morning will begin early with a boucherie and a 5k Run sponsored by Cameron's Shoes Foundation.
