Resolution of Funding Support for 2016 Illinois Transportation
Enhancement Program Grant Project

WHEREAS: the Newton City Council wants to support recreational projects that encourage a healthy lifestyle as well as economic development; and

WHEREAS: the Council is committed to the completion of a Pedestrian/Bicycle Project to improve existing facilities by making them more accommodating and/or accessible for pedestrian and bicycle use. The project is proposed to complete a path from the Phase 3 Project area to the Newton Aquatic Center (Phase 1).

WHEREAS: the Council understands that pedestrian/bicycle facilities will provide worthwhile benefits; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Newton apply for a **\$1,320,000.00** grant from the 2016 Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program and support the project by providing the required local match with **\$264,000.00** in funding or donations as defined under the Federal Flexible Match Program.
