Dear Parishioners,

On Sunday April 22 we will be celebrating First Communion Mass at 8:30am. This is such an important time for our First Communicants, their families and our church and school communities. Our First Communicants have been preparing academically and spiritually for this sacrament for some time. They have the understanding they are receiving the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Pope Francis has stated "It's important for children to properly prepare for their First Communion, so that there's no child without this Sacrament. The Eucharist is a firm step towards Jesus, along with Baptism and Confirmation." Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation are the three sacraments that once received the individual becomes fully initiated in to our church.

It is important that parents, God parents and other family members walk in this journey and continue to guide their children in their faith. May the Lord always provide you with the strength and love you need. It is important that our children witness firsthand the importance of praying, attending church regularly and form that continued friendship with God.

I humbly ask that you continue to pray for our First Communicants, Adam, Tessa, Rylee, Sara, Brock, Evan, Blaise, Noah, Gage, Jack and Finn. Pope Francis also stated that "The Eucharist is such a great gift. That's why going to Mass is so important. Going to Mass not just to pray, but to receive Communion, the Body and Blood of Christ. It saves us, forgives us and it makes us one with the Father. How beautiful!" "The Eucharist is more than just a mere feast. It's a way to remember Jesus' Passover, a mystery that's central to our salvation. But when we talk about 'remembering' that doesn't mean that it's just a memory. It means that every time we celebrate this Sacrament we become part of the Mystery of His Passion, Death and Resurrection. The Eucharist is the peak of God's Salvation."
