### Message of Salvation

**Grace**...Heaven is a free gift

"The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23) We cannot earn our way to heaven and none of us really deserve to go. It is a gift.

**Man**...We are all sinners

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23) Every person who has ever lived has missed God's standard of perfection.
