- To qualify, all animals must be free of any evidence of infectious or contagious disease.
 Superintendent identification Purebred animals must be identified by registry name and number, corresponding to the ear tag or tattoo number. Grade animals must be identified by farm-flock number, corresponding to the ear tag or tattoo number.
- 2. Ages of animals will be reckoned from Sept. 1st -- that is born before August 31st will be one year old, and after Sept. 1st will be two years old, etc.
- 3. Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions, must be removed from the fairgrounds.
- 4. Pen lambs consist of two ram lambs and two ewe lambs.
- 5. Flock lambs consist of one ram, any age; two ewe, one year and under two years; two ewe under one year.
- 6. Breeder's young flock consist of one ram lamb and two ewe lambs, all bred and owned by the exhibitor.
- 7. A Get of Sire consists of four breeding animals, any age or sex, the Get of One Sire. Get need not be owned by exhibitor.
