Slatemont Firewise Activity Reporting Meadows of Dan, Virginia 24120

This is a list of activities you should document as Firewise projects you perform in and around your home and our community. Documenting these activities serves several purposes. We are required to document activities for annual Firewise certification and allow Slatemont to be eligible for Department of Forestry grants when appropriate. These are NOT the only activities that should be documented, but list common projects we frequently perform.

- 1. Fuel reduction in the 5' 100' zones around our homes. Removal of live trees, dead debris(limbs, leaves, shrubbery), relocating shrubs away from your home.
- 2. Replacing or installing non-flammable material around your home. Using stone instead of mulch, railroad ties, wooden walkways.
- 3. Continue to cutback vegetation along our roads. This provides a fire break and allows emergency vehicles easy access when needed.
- 4. Semi-annual Firewise Preparedness days where the community removes fire fuel along our roads, cleans culverts to allow water flow.
- 5. Chipping of limbs and shrubs.
- 6. Keep a log of the hours you work and receipts or copies of checks for any expenditure for these activies.
