

Glidden, Albertine

Albertine "Al" Glidden, 95, of Sand Point passed away on Friday, Oct. 25, 2002, at Scheurer Long Term Care Unit in Pigeon. She was born on Oct. 19, 1907, in Chicago, the daughter of the late Herman and Zerline (Benjamin) Kleinschmidt. On Sept. 10, 1932, she was united in marriage to Benjamin Frank Glidden in Marrietta, Ohio. He preceded her in death on Nov. 28, 1971. Mr. and Mrs. Glidden established the Caseville IGA grocery store in the early 1960s and operated the Bay Port Store and the Owendale Grocery for many years. She was a homemaker and loved being with her family. She was a charter member of the Order of the Eastern Star Mera Chapter of Prairie Village, Kan. and was a member of Scenic Golf and Country Club in Pigeon for many years. Mrs. Glidden was a former member of the Old Mission Methodist Church in Kansas City, Kan. and a current member of the Caseville United Methodist Church. She is survived by a son, Richard Glidden and his wife, Takeko, of Owendale; a daughter, Diane Watson and her husband, John, of Sand Point; six grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren.
