There are many factors for the massive job losses in Pakistan, and Covid19 has turned the situation devastating for the media workers and their families. During the past few months, news channels Capital TV cameraman Fayyaz and City 42 cameraman Rizwan Malik, have died after struggling with depression, poverty, and waiting for their unpaid wages; not paid for as long as nine months.
