Researches and reports on any State and National legislation which has an impact on TRIO Programs and/or first generation, low income students. This position also serves as the liaison between the Council for Opportunity in Education (COE), WESTOP, and the SoCal Chapter.

Committee Goals & Priorities

- Transition duties from Horacio Aceves to Cuauhtemoc Solorio
- Meet with WESTOP Leg/Ed Chair in order to align goals with Regional Chapter
- Begin to update Fact Book with new increased amounts and supplemental funding for TS programs

Committee Updates

- 371 TRIO TS Supplemental applications were received and all have been recommended for funding. Slate has yet to be approved, should be finalized within the next couple of weeks.
- Senate Appropriations Committee released the Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education ("LHHS") Appropriations bill for FY2020, which recommended level-funding TRIO at \$1.06 billion.
- SSS competition: During COE, Deputy Under Secretary Diane Auer Jones stated that without any finality in the appropriations process, conducting such a competition posed the risk that the competition could be cancelled (if Congress ultimately zeroed out funding for a program.) The Department expects to release the final application in late October/early November.
