

# New York Aster



This Native perennial has a long bloom period. It attracts lots of butterflies. There is great variation in flower color from plant to plant. Also known as Michaelmas Daisy it will perform best in a moist to wet meadow and is known to be deer resistant.

## *Aster novi-belgii*

- Hardiness Zone: 4-8
- Size: 3-4'
- Flower: 1-2" wide clusters of pink, purple or white from late summer to fall
- Culture: Prefers full sun and moist well-drained soils
- Uses: Border, naturalizing, cut flower, meadow, butterflies, deer resistant
