As you may already know, BSI is a deed restricted community. The deed restrictions mandate that all proposed new construction requires approval of the Burnt Store Isles Association (BSIA) Board of Directors. The Association is responsible for ensuring that new homes planned for construction meet permit requirements, deed restrictions, and fit within the existing aesthetics of BSI.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Our application fee is \$250.00. The fee includes review and approval of specific documentation and any needed site visits. The new homeowner will also receive a one-year complimentary membership in BSIA when the homeowner takes possession of the new home. If this home is to be used as a "Model Home" there is an additional \$500 fee.

TRAFFIC REMINDER

We continue to receive complaints from our residents concerning speeding traffic and the use of Tripoli to avoid making a U-turn on Route 41 from Madrid to go northbound, per the traffic pattern established by Florida Department of Transportation. These are general complaints and we have no details about which vehicles are causing the concerns. However, to avoid any future issues, please remind your employees as well as your sub-contractors the speed limit is posted at 30 mph throughout BSI. Also request they do not use Tripoli and Monaco to go north on Route 41.
