A miscommunication occurred between the Chief Operator during the 3rd quarter of 2022 and the Operator-In-Training at that time. Each thought the other one was performing the quarterly water sample to test for HAA5/TTHM for that quarter. This oversight was not discovered until after the end of the month for that quarterly reporting period, therefore a violation was received for non-submission. The board addressed the problem with the staff involved and made a plan that clearly identified who would be responsible for performing these tests in the future per schedule required. The issue has now been resolved and all sample/tests have been performed per schedule and met the current EPA quality
