In our area malaria is prevalent and the lack of netted sleeping quarters will end in heartbreak for some families.

Thankfully our children and buildings at TMC were/are in no danger as the Cyclone by-passed us (Thankyou for praying !!!)

and our staff is doing ok physically but and dealing with collapsed homes damaged roof grass and no supply of grass available and not a few toilets, kitchens. So many things are needed, swift rising food prices is an issue..

As in 2015 the days coming will be a great challenge as thousands of people have been displaced and so many homes destroyed, crops destroyed, grass for rebuilding houses will be unavailable as it is likely washed away if not burnt off previous to the floods, by grass sellers who do so to restrict supply and drive up prices. The price of maize will likely skyrocket as will beans. Vegetables are already in scarce supply as this is the season of limited vegetable supply anyway.

Cholera is now and will be an ongoing concern as many toilets have been flooded and destroyed creating open defecation and the resulting disease spread. We have some funds designated for TMC operations we can borrow from as long as it can be replaced when rain/flood donations arrive??? Which ever way you may choose to join in It would help to have an email from you saying we have sent this much **designated to** ...or are going to send... so we can plan a bit... As we are able we will assist in every area we can food, soya pieces, beans, supplies....feeding programs are needed, blankets, plates, cups, cooking pots, candles, mosquito coils, salt, bathing n washing soaps, so many people... It is now April 5. Nine-days without food. The people are selling everything they can. Yes some get help tht shouldn't ... but a bigger yes is ... many get help that should.
