




# Attending Mass Please arrive 15 to 30 minutes prior to Mass to allow for check in and seating

Each Mass may have a maximum of 50 people in attendance. To reserve a place, you must call the parish office at 857-4223, Monday to Friday. (Deadline to reserve for weekend Mass is <u>Friday at 12:00noon</u>). Please note: you must register for weekday Mass also.

Additional weekend Masses have been added to St. Augustine's, please see Mass schedule. To register for Mass at Our Lady of Mercy please call Odette at 531-0252 or Mike at 351-4263. We will continue the original weekday schedule. We will do our best to ensure that each parishioner will get to attend Mass. Please be patient as we implement these new measures.

#### Please follow these guidelines:

In the parking lot, stay safely 6 feet apart.

At the church entrance, stop and allow the volunteer to check you in.

Inside the door, stop and you will be given hand-sanitizer (your hands will be 'squirted')

Inside the church, follow the volunteer to your assigned seat

During Mass, follow all arrows and markings on the floor, so we all stay safely 6 feet apart

During Mass, enjoy the Music Ministry, Hum along, but for now, no singing.

After Mass, respect the safety of keeping the 6 feet between you and your fellow parishioners while leaving the building and when out in the parking lot.

#### Dispensation from Mass

During this pandemic, the dispensation of Sunday Mass is given to those who can not go, those fearful to go, and those advised not to go, to church. Rather, these faithful are invited to read the Word of God and to pray in their homes and to participate in the celebrations of the Mass via TV. radio and/or the Internet.

Those who are sick (fever, cough, etc), those over the age of 70 and those with medical or at-risk conditions are asked to assess their own risk and ultimately, to make their own decision. For your own safety and to increase your comfort level, we encourage everyone to wear his or her own mask.

Please know that before each Mass, every pew, railing, door handle and all bathrooms will have been cleaned and sanitized.



#### **Exploring our Faith**

#### Do Not Be Afraid

In the Gospel for this Sunday it states that Jesus said to His apostles, "Fear no one; for nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered, and nothing secret that will not become known. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the light; and what you hear whispered, proclaim from the housetops. Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul." In saying these words, Jesus describes the worth of human beings in the eyes of God, who knows all things.

Fear is a part of life and part of each of our own daily lives. We are afraid of many things; failure, death, violence, the rise of terrorism and religious intolerance in our world and in our country. Apparently the words "Do Not Be Afraid" appear 365 times in the Bible. That's one for every day of the year! How can we cope with these fears? As a child, I learned that if I woke up in the middle of the night I should say a prayer, say my rosary and it would give me comfort because God was always there watching over me. It is very simplistic but it worked many times. I have my mother's rosary under my pillow to this day and I've often allayed my early morning anxieties by my



childhood habit. Henri Nouwen stated, "When I trust deeply that today God is truly with me and holds me safe in a divine embrace, guiding every one of my steps, I can let go of my anxious need to know how tomorrow will look, or what will happen next month or next year. I can be fully where I am and pay attention to the many signs of God's love within me and around me."

"Do not be afraid" offers us hope, strength and courage when we are in doubt or struggling in any way. Mother Teresa said "Inhale courage, Exhale fear." We are all capable of following the belief that God is always with us, trusting that we will receive love and always more love.

Richard Rohr phrased fear in an acronym: False Evidence Appearing Real

Maybe we should think about these words and realize that we CAN face what we think is fear. By living an authentic faith we can face hardship, can be empowered to live more generously, more trustfully and yet, more bravely.
