Carl E. Reid, 44, Detroit, former Elkton photographer, passed away unexpectedly Wednesday night while attending a theatre.

Mr. Reid was born April 12, 1910 at Onaway, Michigan. He lived in Elkton and vicinity about 10 years. He spent 38 months in the Armed Forces during World War II.

Surviving are his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Clinton McBride, Elkton, who were spending the winter in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and a brother Armond Reid, Detroit.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at two o'clock at the James T. Colgan Funeral Chapel, with Rev. Emmett Coons, pastor of the Elkton Methodist church, officiating. Burial was in the Caseville cemetery.
