Bitches in season shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the grounds. All handlers, judges, workers and gallery members <u>must</u> be attired in an article of Blaze orange while on the Club's grounds. **Quail** and/or Chukars and/or Pheasant and/or Pigeons, to be released for all test levels.

The Water Test will be held at Farmland Conservation Club. Ducks may be used in the Water Test; a blank pistol must be fired by the handler. Club is not responsible for providing pistols. Pistols used must be incapable of firing live rounds.
