May 14 Depart from JFK International Airport, NY

May 15 (Wednesday) Arrive at Heathrow around 7:00 am. Travel to **Winchester** for self-guided walking tour. Travel next to Stonehenge. Conclude the day in **Bath**. Lodging for the night: Francis on the Square Hotel.

May 16 (Thursday) Tour the Roman Baths before traveling to **Bristol** for the New Room and Charles Wesley's House. After lunch, we stop at Wells Cathedral. From there we travel to Torquay (*known as the English Riviera and birthplace to Agatha Christie*). Lodgings for the next two nights: The Livermead House in Torquay.

May 17 (Friday) we visit Wesley's Cottage at **Trewint**, Altarnun Church, then Gwennap Pit. Lunch at the Kings Head. On return we visit the Mayflower Steps in **Plymouth**. Back to The Livermead House for the evening.

May 18 (Saturday) we make our way up the coast to **Shaldon** with lunch at our tour hosts home church, meet a few local Methodists and time to look around the village. Leave for London. Lodging for next two nights: The Plaza on the River (*along the River Thames*). Dinner on your own.

May 19 (Sunday) Leave hotel after breakfast, making our way to Wesley's Chapel City Road in **London** for morning worship service. Will do a light packed lunch after which we visit The Museum and John Wesley's House and Grave. Blue Badge tour guide joins us on the coach and takes us around a few more Wesley sites, St. Bartholomew the Great (*oldest church in London*) then finish up at St Paul's Cathedral. Travel back to hotel. Dinner on your own. For those who wish, time should permit Evensong at Westminster Abbey.

May 20 (Monday) Depart early for The Tower of London. Stay about four hours then make our way to **Lincoln**. Lodgings next two nights: The White Hart Hotel. Evening meal.

May 21 (Tuesday) We have free time in the morning for a leisure visit in the town of **Lincoln**. Some may opt for visit to the Lincoln Cathedral and/or Lincoln Castle (*where original Magna Carta is stored*). Travel to **Epworth**, visit the Rectory first with light lunch followed by St Andrews Church, where we will receive Holy Communion from the chalice of Samuel Wesley. Return to Lincoln for evening meal.

May 22 (Wednesday) We travel directly to **Oxford**, arriving early afternoon which will give us opportunity to explore Oxford (some will want to visit the Ashmolean Museum or the Bodleian Library). Lodging remainder of trip: The Linton Lodge of Oxford. Evening meal.

May 23 (Thursday) The day will be free apart from our scheduled visit to Lincoln College. Evening meal.

May 24 (Friday) We visit Windsor Castle, leave after breakfast returning by late afternoon. Free till dinner at the Rose Revived (*terrific English Pub on the banks of the River Thames*).

May 25 (Saturday) To Heathrow and your return to the USA.

Additional Information:

The above listing of events and venues is partial and subject to revision. There is much more to be seen (e.g., in London -- Buckingham Palace, London Bridge, Trafalgar Square, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Wesley House, Bunhill Fields, Charterhouse School, etc.)

Our tour leader, Arthur Pengelly, is a member of the British Methodist Church.

The hotels are three and four star, although some may be very old. Our rooms are in their recent additions including all the comforts of home. Each hotel will provide classroom space and **we will meet for class every morning from 7 - 8:30 am** (subject to changes made by instructors and travel adjustments).

The food is excellent! All breakfasts and most dinners are included in the cost as is admission to all the venues scheduled for entire group. Travelers will be responsible for 5 or 6 of their own lunches and a few dinners. You will also be responsible for your trip to and from our point of departure in New York. Rooms are double occupancy. Limited single rooms will be available at an estimated supplemental charge of \$625.

For students, if your spouse accompanies you, we will deduct \$300 from the spouse's cost. Church members and lay folks and **seminary students** are encouraged to take part in this trip as well. You will not find a more Wesleyan experience. We are limited to 38 people, with students given priority.

COS 122 is required before taking 422. You cannot take both on this trip.

Conditions: Final Payment is due March 14, 2019. We may charge a late fee of \$75 after March 14, 2019. A deduction of \$75 is available if you pay in full by November 15, 2018, or \$50 if paid in full by December 31, 2018. Your price includes all appropriate taxes and fees, one piece of luggage (50 pound maximum and a maximum exterior linear dimension of 62 inches (158 cm) per bag.) plus one carry-on (9 inches x 14 inches x 21.5 inches), admission to all scheduled venues, facilities charges and security fees, and a non-refundable registration fee of \$50. Your price does not include miscellaneous fees such as individual transfer fees, passports, laundry, certain beverages at meals, excess baggage, and/or items of a personal nature. Nor does it include travel insurance which is optional (but which I highly recommend). Fitness for travel: By registering for this trip, you accept responsibility for being in good health and able to walk and travel on this tour. Many sites are not accessible to those with physical challenges. If unsure of your ability, please contact Greg Markins. Price Increases: All prices quoted in this packet are subject to change prior to payment in full due to currency fluctuations, fuel surcharges increases, government taxes and fee increases or unforeseen circumstances. (*This has never happened in any of our travels; it is not likely, but is a possibility*). Likewise, travelers may be subject to price increase after full payment received in the event of potential government-imposed taxes and fees. Meals included in your price are breakfast and a set dinner menu daily except in London where meals will be on your own. Lunches will be on your own with exception of one or two days. Accommodations are in three- and four-star hotels, double occupancy. Single rooms are limited and there will be a \$625 supplemental charge if you desire a single room. Airline tickets, once printed, cannot be refunded or amended. Our international flight will be nonstop from NY to London with a major carrier. The optional travel insurance covers cancellation if your reason is insurable. If cancellation occurs from day of registration until March 14, 2019 the penalty is \$150; from March 15 to March 30, \$350; from April 1 to April 15, \$850; from April 16 to April 30, \$1,700; after April 30, \$3,645. Any airline penalties would be added in each case. On or after the day of departure there can be no refund for any unused services.

All the “fine print” which you see above is included for our mutual understanding. We have tried to cover all the bases and there are no hidden costs or conditions lurking out there to take advantage of first-time travelers or seasoned explorers. Your main additional cost will be your transportation from your home to JFK, New York and some meals.

Our agent will gladly work with you on getting the best deal in travel from your home to NY. Generally, by bundling with international flight, your commuter flight will be minimal. You are certainly free to make your own domestic airline arrangements.

Whether you make domestic air arrangements with her or not, she is still probably the one to contact for the best trip insurance rate.

You need a valid passport. Local US Post Offices have forms and directions. It generally takes about a month for the Post Office to process your passport. If you have a passport but it is set to expire in less than 6 months from trip departure date, you should renew it before the trip.

Discover cards are not very welcome in England but Visa, MasterCard, American Express are. Let your card carrier know when you are going to England, so they can arrange for you to draw cash in English pounds when you arrive. Same for debit cards.

Some of our students on former trips enjoyed financial support of their Annual Conference as well as receiving financial assistance from their churches. The courses we offer are official courses available through the Course of Study School in Ohio and The Part-time Local Pastors' School at Spring Heights, WV and offered in England.
