

WFHS JAGS FOOTBALL QBC MEETING OF 15 FEBRUARY 2016

5:35pm Rusty Smith brought the meeting to order. Elizabeth Richardson offered the invocation.

OLD BUSINESS: Last meeting's minutes posted.

ATTENDEES: See roster.

NEW BUSINESS:

ITEM 1: BOSTON BUTT SALES

- Sold 204 during last cook.
- Help Needed: Need extra men to help with prep work for future cooks (rubbing seasonings, putting on smokers). Show up at 0600 to put them on the smoker; come back in the evening to remove them from the smoker. Tyler has been staying there with the smoker, but that will change this year. When that happens, we will need volunteers to stay with the cooker throughout the day.
- Last year we sold 1107 Boston Butts over seven cook events. At approximately \$15 profit per butt, that provides \$125 per player.
- Suggestion: Make Boston Butts a committee so the group knows who will man the cooker.
- April 7th: Next Boston Butt cook. Orders cutoff is Thur, 31 Mar at 1600.
- Need foil donations (large heavy-duty rolls from Sam's Club).
- Typical Boston Butt Cook schedule:
 - Tues orders placed
 - Wed orders received (near lunch time). Unload at Woodham. Deliver cooker that afternoon.
 - Take 50ish out and start seasoning. Need help at 5:00pm.
 - 6:00am Thur – remove from smoker; wrap them. Put new ones in the smoker.
 - 5:00pm Thur – same
 - 6:00am Fri – same
 - 5:00pm Fri – same
 - Need 3-4 people per shift

ITEM 2: FUNDRAISING

- Collect dues at the beginning of the season.
- Offer payout in lieu of fundraising requirements.
- Track fundraising efforts; place a fundraising requirement.
- Spirit packs: Make a purchase requirement.

ITEM 6: HELMETS
