Although very common, all injections in the mid-face require a skillful hand, knowledge of the product and experience. And facial injections are not without



serious risks if done improperly. Always ask the practitioner you visit - before you have a treatment done - if he/she is experienced in the process of facial injections, and does them on a regular basis. Little known to patients is the very serious fact that the facial artery has branches that go to the nose and the eyes. Expertise is required to avoid injecting filler into a blood vessel in this area. For the new Restylane Lyft, typically, patients require two syringes on the first visit and then, in 9-12 months, perhaps a touch-up with one syringe may be needed to accomplish the ongoing desired results. From that point on touch-ups are used to maintain fullness of the cheeks.
