Seaworthy Ark

For many years, creationists have affirmed the stability of Noah's ark by comparing its dimensions to modern vessels. Now S. W. Hong and colleagues at the Korea Research Institute of Ships and Ocean Engineering have applied sophisticated testing techniques to evaluate the safety of the ark (*Creation Ex Nihilo Technical Journal*, 1994, 8:26-36).

On the assumption that the ark was a drifting, barge-like ship, the scientist constructed computer and 1/50 scale models. They analyzed overall safety by studying the ark's structural integrity, overturning stability, and seakeeping quality (i.e., how well a ship resists flooding in high seas). Also, they juggled the dimensions to see whether the arks 30:5:3 (length, breadth, height) ratio conferred the greatest overall safety for this type of craft.

The researchers found that the ark's structure could easily withstand stresses imposed by waves 36 feet high, and was thirteen times more stable in such conditions than the standard for overturning required by the American Bureau of Shipping. Also, the ark could encounter waves at least 98 feet high without flooding.

Finally, the ark did better than most over designs with the same displacement, by different dimensions. Shorter vessels with wider beams had greater structural safety and overturning stability, but had less seakeeping safety. Deeper vessels with narrower beams had better structural and seakeeping safety, but less stability. Overall, the ark's design would have ensured the safety of its occupants in seas that would frighten most seasoned mariners.
