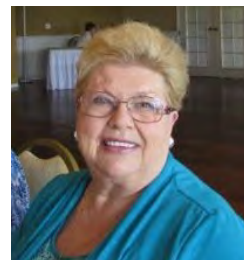

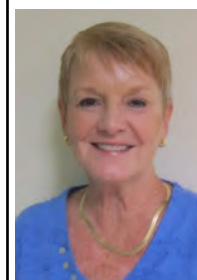
MEET OUR MEMBERS

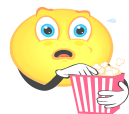

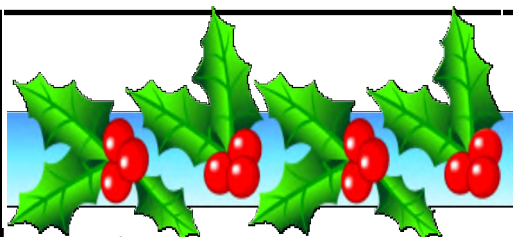
